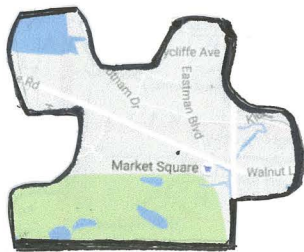

HOW WE HELP:

At Walnut Lake Preschool & Developmental Kindergarten, parents, teachers, and child development specialists work together to build a network to support effective communication. Our focus is on social and emotional growth and the building of healthy relationships. This is the foundation for learning and growth in all other areas. We understand that our relationship with you begins the moment you contact us. Our individualized curriculum emerges from each child's interests and needs.

WE UNDERSTAND. WE CAN HELP.

Most often, a child's difficulties are the result of a complex combination of emotional, behavioral, and developmental challenges. With early intervention and our multidisciplinary approach, Walnut Lake Preschool & Developmental Kindergarten provides the promise of learning how to recognize, express, and master feelings. Children are respected as individuals and develop a sense of their own competence as they interact with the world. They become more loving and compassionate with themselves and others.



Children in our program frequently move on to traditional school settings with greater capacities to learn, communicate, and have friends.



In our specialized classrooms, we combine the best practices in early childhood education with therapeutic services to strengthen your child's emotional resources, social capacities, cognitive development, motor skills, speech and language.

We work individually with each parent and child to strengthen the school experience and to enhance the parent-child tie. We look for the meaning behind behaviors and what children are trying to tell us through their actions. We can help them learn to express themselves in a language we can understand.

settings. We offer a low child-to-staff ratio (4:1 or better) allowing children to receive individual support and attention throughout the day.

A family consultant is available to each family as an expert resource in child development. Parents meet regularly with the consultant, who also observes in the classroom and consults with the teaching staff.

We offer free monthly parenting workshops led by child development specialists on different topics. The opportunity is provided to discuss any individual concerns and comments in the growth of your children. We offer extended hours, which provide continuity for children throughout the day.
